## Yosef was the perfect GrassFarmer



An outsider among the Egyptians

Yet, unrecognizable to his brothers

Even before they left, these spies could never have truly belonged!

<sup>\*</sup> The mat'e of the 'children of Yosef' is mentioned later. This is in a reference only to Menashe; half of whom made themselves outsiders by living across the Jordan. They made themselves outsiders, reinforcing the concept that Yosef never quite belonged.



All that are homeborn shall do these things after this manner, in presenting an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

Teach your children they'll have flour, wine and oil – products of the land. They will belong.

All natives have to use the products of the land to serve Hashem. They will not be Am Haaretz


#### You are not 'Am Haaretz', but Am Hashem in Eretz Hashem


## Bringing it all together!

#### Techelet is the color of the sky

- + Our continual use of fabric
- = A constant reminder that we are Am Hashem, not Am Haaretz (or grasshoppers)
